

"COME AND SEE" THE CELIBATE LIFE From our Pastor, Fr. James Kulway

Hi, everyone! I am extremely grateful for an amazing day last Sunday for our parish picnic! The weather was beautiful, the turnout was wonderful, and I had many people come up to me and offer very positive comments about our parish and the direction we are headed. I want to give a huge thank you to Parish Council for hosting this event! Matt Kerns, the head of council, and other council members from parish and finance council did an incredible job organizing and executing this event. We are grateful to them and all the volunteers for all of their hard work. Thank you to the musicians who sang beautifully for us! Thank you to all who came to this event. I love the opportunity for us all to be together, celebrate the Liturgy together, and enjoy food, fellowship, fun and good times together.

As I mentioned last weekend in the Mass announcements, we will be hosting our first "Come and See" evening here at St. Barnabas. In the life of the Church, people are either called to celibate life or married life. Technically, nobody is "single." A person is either called by God to marriage and family life, which makes up most of the population, or a person is called to celibate life, which is fully embracing a marriage to God. Jesus and John the Baptist were celibate. And all the way back to the early Church there were many people who embraced celibacy as a calling from God. Celibates devote their entire life to God. A married person devotes their life to God and to his or her spouse and children.

I thought for the first twenty years of my life that I was called to marriage. As I came closer to Christ I understood He was calling me to "renounce marriage for the sake of the Kingdom (Matthew 19:12)." In a sense God was calling me to marriage but in a different way. I was called to embrace marriage with Him which we will all eventually embrace fully in Heaven. Celibates embrace that eternal marriage with Christ on earth. Celibacy

is modeled after Jesus who was celibate and gave His whole life to the Father for His Bride the Church. Celibate persons have a calling to renounce the good of earthly marriage and fully embrace a marriage with God. This is not just for priests but also for lay people who embrace what we call "consecrated life." This group consists of religious sisters, nuns, brothers, consecrated virgins etc.

In the early Church, many of the Apostles were celibate and many of the early martyrs were celibate. We have many writings of young women from the first few centuries who refused to marry and said boldly that they were spouses to Jesus. Many of them died as martyrs in the early Church. When I pray the Roman Canon Eucharistic prayer (longer prayer for consecration) at Mass, at the end I say the names: Matthias, Barnabas, Ignatius, Alexander, Marcellinus, Peter, Felicity, Perpetua, Agatha, Lucy, Agnes, Cecilia, Anastasia and all your Saints. Many (if not all) of these are celibate martyrs of the early Church.

This "Come and See" evening will be hosted on Friday, June 28 at 5:30 p.m. This is an opportunity for those who are discerning celibacy (priesthood, religious life, consecrated life) to come, learn more, and have some quality discussion about the celibate vocation.


