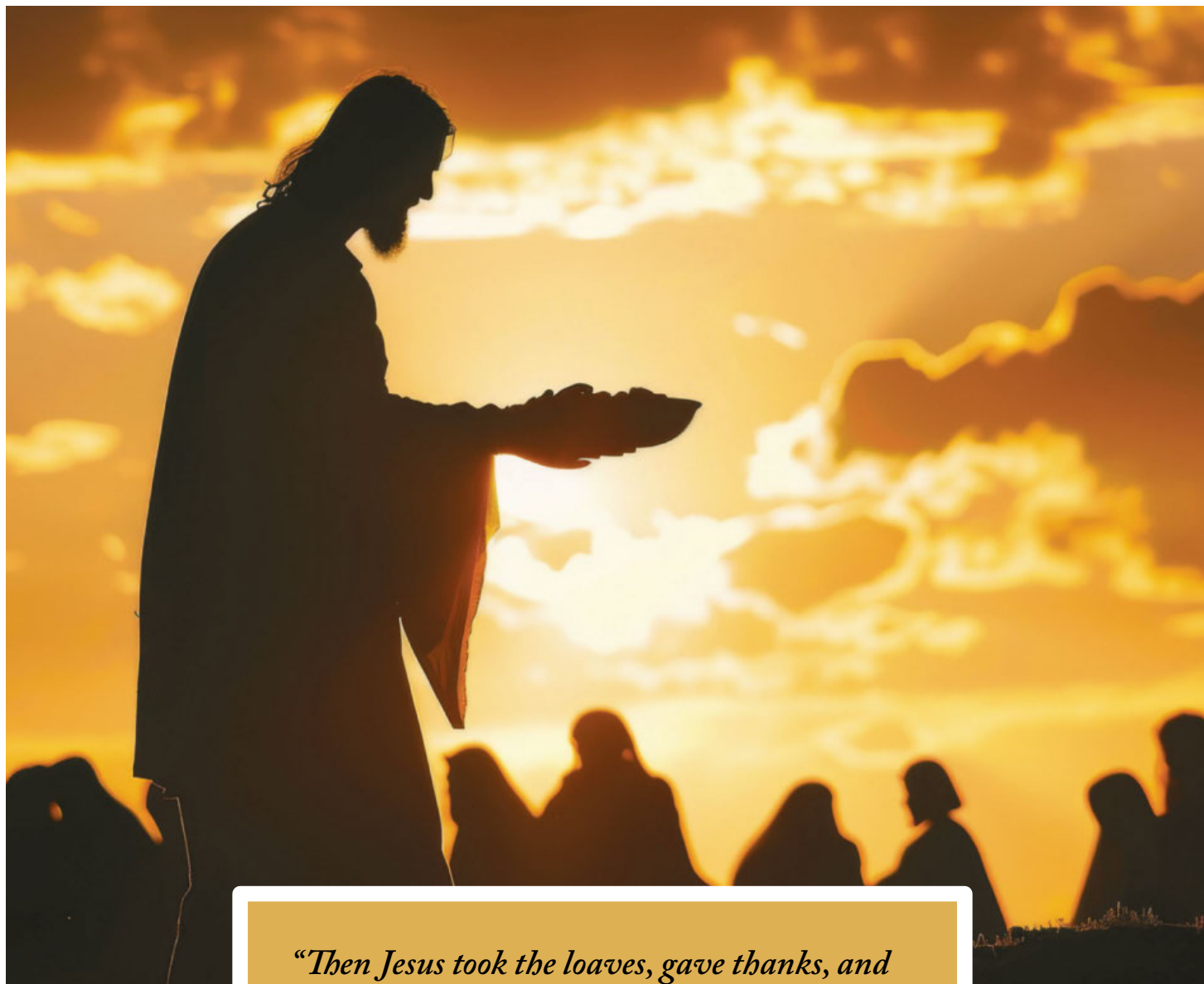

## JESUS TRANSFORMS THE ORDINARY

From our Pastor, **Fr. James Kulway**

Hi, everyone! I am very excited to begin our year of St. Barnabas the weekend of August 17 and 18! Please join us for Mass that weekend to kick off our Patron Saint. I will preach each Mass to learn more about Saint Barnabas and how we can best emulate him. After each Mass, we will pass out pens and decals with our new logo and have a treat for the kids after the 10:30 a.m. Mass. I hope to see you and gather our community for this kickoff—join us!

I would like to continue to thank you all for your excitement, participation, and good questions regarding our Church Renovation project. I have been meeting with the building commission team to revise our plans and have discussion and feedback about this project. I look forward to beginning our fundraising in October. As I stated last month, I will host another Town Hall meeting on Monday, August 26, from 6:30–8:00 p.m. to roll out the architectural designs and give you a clearer vision of what this remodel will look like. Thank you again for your enthusiastic support and prayers for the remodeling of our worship space!

In our Gospel for this weekend, we hear of Jesus multiplying the five loaves and two fish to feed the 5,000. This is a great miracle and mystery that Jesus offers at this point of His journey. It is important to remember that coming to know Christ is about living our lives in these mysteries that He reveals to us. Knowing and following Jesus is about following His commands, loving our neighbor, and doing good works. But the Christian life gets interesting when we live in the mysteries Christ presents to us.





In this particular scene, Jesus takes the ordinary, small amount and transforms it into something extraordinary. With this small, ordinary amount, with what they have, Jesus is able to produce great fruit and feed thousands

of people! We hear of something similar at the wedding feast at Cana. Jesus changes ordinary water into the best of wines. The ordinary becomes something extraordinary. Both of these mysteries foreshadow the Eucharist we receive each week where ordinary bread and wine become something extraordinary – the real presence of Christ – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity!

Each and every day, we should bring to Jesus the “ordinary” of our lives. We bring Jesus “what we have.” At some point it is up to Him to make it extraordinary. But it is up to us to bring Him what we have. We want to live our lives in the mystery of our faith. We want to witness the Lord transforming our ordinary offering into something extraordinary.

When I think of these last few years at St. Barnabas, I think of many instances this has happened. I think of our first outdoor Mass during COVID. We offered an ordinary opportunity and the Lord blessed it with a huge turnout and excitement for the parish going forward (and lots of rain)! I think of running with parishioners – this is something very ordinary to my life that has allowed me to connect with many parishioners, kids, and parents during CYO Cross Country and Track, which has been blessed and multiplied with great fruit for relationship building **(continued on page 4)...**

### Swiss Papal Guard

The Pope is protected by the Swiss Papal Guard. Wearing uniforms designed by Michelangelo and commonly armed with halberds, they are capable of using heavier weapons if needed. Each member is Catholic, male, and Swiss, and must complete military training in Switzerland. They must demonstrate good conduct and be at least five-foot-eight in height. Those who are chosen are granted a private audience with the Pope along with their families. In extreme circumstances, they are expected to guard the Holy Father with their lives. The Swiss Papal Guard is the oldest active military unit in continual existence since 1506.
