

### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Hi, everyone! I hope your Lent is off to a good start. We had a great turnout for our opening fish fry last Friday. The volunteers and scouts do a wonderful job hosting and serving this event each Friday during Lent.



Please come for a great dine-in or takeout experience! Also, please come and pray the Stations of the Cross at 7 p.m. Friday evenings during Lent. We have different staff members leading the Stations each Friday.

I am grateful for the opportunity to lead several evening prayer workshops during Lent. We had our first session this past Wednesday. Again, it is my goal to help you all cultivate that deeper relationship with God in your life. Prayer comes very easy for some people and not so easy for others. God desires an active relationship with all of us, regardless of how easy or difficult it is to pray. I am using this as an opportunity to do some teaching on prayer but my main goal is to give you time to have personal prayer with some guidance.

The most important thing I can do as a priest is help you to have an encounter with Jesus and learn how to live in Him. Lent is the perfect opportunity to open up this space of our lives even more. Many of us go to Mass and feel we are just going through the motions. Sometimes going to Mass can feel more like a chore than a place where we are fed. Sometimes trying to live the Christian moral life authentically can just feel like a lot of work and exhausting. I really believe If we do not have a good relationship with the Lord this will lead to Christianity feeling like a chore. Prayer is where we gain strength, insight, rest, and the grace to live the way God asks of us. Prayer has the power to heal our hearts and give us fresh eyes as we look into our lives. You will not regret growing in your prayer life!

Last week we reflected on the Spirit leading Jesus into the desert where He was tempted by Satan. The 40 days of Jesus in the desert before He began His public ministry is the reason for our yearly 40 days of Lent practice. We seek to imitate Christ in our lives and so we do as He did. As we reflected last week, the desert is real in all of our lives. In the great mystery of God's love for us He does allow us to go through dry, desolate times. God allows us to be tempted and our faith tested. We read about Abraham's faith being tested this week in our first reading from Genesis when he is asked to sacrifice his son Isaac. We experience plenty of trials and challenges in life. Many of these do not often make sense. However, it is important that we persevere in prayer and remain faithful to God in these trying times. The reality is we will get through these hard times in our lives only with God's help. How the ending will look is up to the Lord, but we will come through them in Christ.
