

"THORN IN THE FLESH" From our Pastor, Fr. James Kulway

Hi, everyone! I hope you had a wonderful Fourth of July holiday last week! I was always told that after the Fourth, summer is over. This sounds crazy, but in some ways, it seems to be true - August and the start of the school year come very quickly from here!

I am very excited this week for Vacation Bible School. For the past several years, this has been a great success, and I know it will be again this year. It's truly been a blessing for the past several years to see the large turnout, and it's always a blessing to have time to teach the kids about our faith. Please pray for our kids this week!

When I looked at the scripture readings for this weekend, I was immediately drawn to the second reading from Paul's letter to the Corinthians. This passage brings back memories of praying with this scripture text in the past. I find it relatable to life situations and helpful in approaching difficult situations. St. Paul talks about this "thorn in the flesh" experience. We do not know exactly what this issue is that St. Paul is having. It might be a physical, mental or spiritual pain. Maybe he has some sort of illness that will not go away. It is difficult to say exactly what he is talking about, but the bottom line is that St. Paul is having trouble with something in his life and asks Jesus to remove it from his life. Of course, we can all relate to this – everyone! We all have had or will have a "thorn in the flesh" experience. Sometimes it is a personal health issue or a family burden, or some other worry altogether. Every one of us can identify with St. Paul here.

Similar to St. Paul, we ask God for help or relief. In 2 Corinthians 12:7-10, Paul seeks to remove a challenge, and Jesus replies, "My grace is enough for you; my power is perfected in weakness." Many of us seek relief from trials, as did Paul. Yet, through prayer and Jesus' words, Paul learns to embrace trials by seeking support and strength from the Lord. Just as God guided Paul, He may be guiding us in our own challenges.

Lastly, St. Paul proclaims something revolutionary, "I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell with me. Therefore, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and constraints, for the sake of Christ; for when I am weak, then I am strong." After praying with this and not getting what he wanted, Paul is now able to approach this trial in a totally different way. He is meant to journey in this trial with Christ and to allow His grace to work in it. In other words, he learns to meet Jesus in the trial and discovers that, paradoxically, he is stronger in his weakness than in his strength because of God's grace. Perhaps in the trials that God does not remove in our lives, we are meant to experience something similar. Try taking your own "thorn in the flesh" experience and doing as St. Paul did. Use this reading to assist you in your prayer in this area of your life.



The Altar

An altar, or a table upon which the eucharistic sacrifice is celebrated, is to have a fixed altar in every church, meaning it is constructed to the floor and cannot be moved. According to the traditional practice of the Church, the table of a fixed altar is to be of stone, and of a single natural stone. The supports or base, however, can be made of any material. Fixed altars must be dedicated. The ancient tradition of placing relics of martyrs or other saints under a fixed altar is to be preserved according to the norms in the liturgical books (Sacred Places and Times, Canon Law 1205 - 1243).


